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**INFORMATION REGARDING PERSONS WHO MAY WITNESS A STATUTORY DECLARATION OR BEFORE WHOM A DECLARATION MAY BE MADE IN EACH JURISDICTION**

**South Australia:** Authorised persons include a justice of the peace, notary public, proclaimed members of the S.A. police force and commissioners for taking affidavits (*Oaths Act 1936*).

**Victoria:** Authorised persons include a justice of the peace, lawyer, pharmacist, police officer, court registrar, bank manager, medical practitioner, dentist (*Evidence Act 1958*).

**New South Wales:** Authorised persons include a justice of the peace, notary public, commissioner of the court for taking affidavits, legal practitioner authorized under section 27(1) of Oaths Act 1900 and any other person authorized to administer an oath under section 26 of the Act.

**Western Australia:** Authorised persons include a justice of the peace, local government councillor, officer of the Commonwealth or state public service, teacher, police officer, bank manager and various other persons authorized under the *Oaths, Affidavits and Statutory Declarations Act 2005*.

**Queensland:** Authorised persons include a commissioner for declarations, notary public, justice of the peace barrister, solicitor, any other person authorized under the *Oaths Act 1867*.

**Tasmania:** Authorized persons include a justice of the peace, commissioner for declarations and any other person authorized under the *Oaths Act 2001*.

**CTH/ACT:** Authorised persons include a justice of the peace, notary public, legal practitioner, commissioner for affidavits, a permanent employee of the Commonwealth or a state government authority with 5 years continuous service and other persons authorized to administer an oath under the *Statutory Declarations Act 1959*

**Northern Territory:** Any person over the age of eighteen (*Oaths Act*).
